On 08.12.2022 the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ *The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing the order dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) vide which the Court below has cancelled the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner and summoned him through NBW of arrest in a case FIR NO.79 dated 22.09.2019 under Section 21 of NDPS Act at P.S. Fatehgarh Churian in District Batala.*

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner inadvertently did not appear on 25.03.2022 before the trial Court. He is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

*Notice of motion for **16.03.2022.***

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the Trial court within a period of one week from today subject to his depositing Rs.10,000/- as cost with Day Care Centre for Elderly Disabled in Home for Old and Destitute People, Sector 15, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

At the time of hearing, the Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with the aforesaid order dated 08.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been granted bail as is evident from the order dated 11.01.2023 passed by Judge, Special Court, Gurdaspur.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from the proceedings in future.
