On 23.10.2023, following order was passed :

"The instant criminal writ petition has been filed for seeking extension of parole granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted parole till 23.10.2023 and is due to surrender on 24.10.2023, however, mother of the petitioner has passed away on 21.10.2023 and the last ceremonies are to be performed on 04.11.2023. It is further submitted that the petitioner being the only surviving son of deceased Roshani Devi, his presence is essential for the above said last ceremonies. It is further submitted that the petitioner has already availed parole during his above said custody for a period of nearly 04 years out of the total sentence awarded to him and there has been no complaint of any nature whatsoever against the petitioner having abused the concession of parole.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Charanjit Singh Bakhshi, A.P.P. for U.T. Chandigarh enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He prays for some time to verify the same. It is further prayed that let the petitioner

surrender tomorrow and fresh parole be granted to him thereafter on verification.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to extend the concession of parole instead of relegating the petitioner to first surrender tomorrow.

List on 31.10.2023.

In the meanwhile, the parole granted to the petitioner is extended till the next date of hearing.

The facts be also verified by the respondents before the next date of hearing.”

Today learned counsel for U.T. has confirmed about the death of the mother of the petitioner. It is also confirmed that last rites of the mother of the petitioner are to be performed on 04.11.2023.

As such, the parole granted to the petitioner is hereby extended till the evening of 05.11.2023. Petitioner is directed to surrender on 05.11.2023 upto 05:00 p.m.
