1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0085, dated 06.10.2023, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women, SAS Nagar, District Mohali.
2. Vide order dated 26.10.2023, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed her to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that pursuant to the said order, the petitioner has joined investigation and his further custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-complainant submits that he has no objection if the order dated 26.10.2023 is confirmed by this Court, since the matter has been compromised between the parties.
