The prayer in the present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to official respondents Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners endangered at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8 because respondent Nos.4 to 8 are adamant to usurp the permanent alimony received by the petitioner Nos.1 and 2 in lieu of dissolution of marriage of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits a representation dated 19.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) was given to official respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda but no action has been taken against respondents Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab has appeared in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the representation made by them to

respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda is directed to be decided expeditiously.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda is directed to decide the representation of petitioners expeditiously and not later than two months and to ensure safety of petitioners and further to ensure that no harm is caused to them.
