The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.304 dated 10.10.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 342, 365, 387, 458, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.01.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Kuldeep Beniwal, DSP Dabwali, Sirsa, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
