1. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 27.10.2023, the following order was passed:-

“By this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of 'prearrest bail' upon FIR No. 68 having been registered at Police Station Sadar, Rampura, District Bathinda, on 25.09.2023, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 353/186/341/323/148/149 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1 Sukhpal Kaur Mann alias Jaspal Kaur, wife of Didar Singh and petitioner No. 2 Baljit Kaur, wife of Daya Singh though named in the FIR but no specific injury has been attributed to them. The petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

The co-accused of the petitioners namely, Didar Singh and Sukhjinder Singh have already been granted the concession of regular bail by the trial Court. Both the petitioners are residents of Village Balloh, Tehsil

Rampura, District Bathinda, and there is no apprehension of their absconding.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Vishnav Gandhi, D.A.G., Punjab appears on behalf of the State and seeks time to file status report.

Adjourned to 23.11.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation within one week and in that event they shall be released on bail, on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Ilaqa Magistrate.

They shall also comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are fully co-operating with the investigation process and they are not required for custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and order dated 27.10.2023 is, hereby, made absolute.
