Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.292 dated 7.7.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC (Sections 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Chandhuth, District Palwal.

On the last date of hearing detailed order was passed whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

Today the counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order

of interim bail passed by this Court and that only simple injury is attributed to the petitioner.

State counsel on instructions from SI Badam Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submitted that recovery of weapon used in commission of offence has been effected. The State counsel apprised the Court that the petitioner to whom only simple injury has been attributed is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 7.12.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
