1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has approached this Court by filing criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) and protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7 and not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioners at their behest.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Amit Bhatia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind filed on behalf of respondent No.1 to 3 in compliance of order dated 27.10.2023 is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner relies upon the statement of the petitioner, which is annexed with the reply as Annexure R-1 to contend that the petitioner is satisfied as she is on talking terms with her parents. She has made a categorical statement that there is no threat to her life and liberty and she does not want any security.

4. In view of the statement made by the petitioner before the police, no further directions are required to be passed. However, if there is any specific

incident/details provided by the petitioner, which warrants action on the part of police authorities/official respondents, appropriate action will be taken by them.

5. The instant petition stands disposed of.
