**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 18.10.2023 whereby application of the petitioner seeking final registration for allotment of paddy has been rejected.

2. The petitioner has purchased his rice mill in public auction from a Bank. The unit was earlier owned and controlled by M/s Bansal Cotton Mills, Lehragaga. The previous owner was considered and allotted paddy, however, application of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that land size is less than prescribed by the Custom Milling Policy 2023-2024 read with instructions dated 17.09.2007.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per policy he has right to offer additional land to make the land as per instructions.

The petitioner undertakes to arrange additional land within 3 days from

today and prays that respondents may be directed to consider claim of the petitioner in terms of policy read with instructions.

4.           Learned State counsel assures the Court that if petitioner arranges additional land within 3 days, the competent authority would look into the matter and decide claim of the petitioner in accordance with policy read with instructions.

5.           In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
