Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 117, dated 24.05.2018, under Sections 381, 120-B IPC (Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise dated 17.12.2018 (Annexure P-2).

On 17.01.2020, request for adjournment had been made as the arguing counsel was not available. None had appeared for the petitioners on 12.10.2022 despite the case having been called twice. On the last date also, i.e. 21.11.2022, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It was specifically mentioned in the order that the date be notified to learned counsel for the petitioners.

As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioners has been informed through email about the date fixed. However, still none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners even today, despite the case having been called twice.

In view of the above, it appears that the petitioners have lost interest in the matter.
