The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions for handing over the investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 228 dated 11.07.2012 under Sections 323, 302 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari to the Central Bureau of Investigation.

Status report by way of affidavit of Subhash Chand, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rewari, District Rewari, reveals as follows:-

“That the complainant Harish Kumar also put in appearance in response to a notice served upon him regarding the closure of investigation. He got recorded his statement before the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari on 09.03.2020 expressing satisfaction with the police proceedings and the untrace report was thereafter accepted vide order dated 09.03.2020 as passed by the court of Ld. Chief Judicial magistrate, Rewari. The copy of the order is enclosed as Annexure R1. The matter has been investigated fairly at length, not only by the District Police, but also by the State Crime Branch, however, the assailants could not be traced. As and when any clue is found regarding the person(s) involved in the occurrence, the needful shall be further done in the matter.”

Learned State counsel submits that in the event, the petitioner

who is the mother of the deceased gets any clue and provides any relevant

information depicting the detail of culprit, if any, the matter will be reopened and further investigated.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the needful will be done as and when such a situation arises and the present petition may be disposed of.
