1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been running from pillar to post but their grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioners have approached the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2, by way of their representation dated 16.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 16.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
