The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.181 dated 25.11.2020 registered under Sections 379 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.02.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 27.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Jitender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Ranbir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 07.02.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
