1. The petitioner has filed the present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 30.04.2016 passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Panipat whereby an application under Sections 151, 152 and 153 of CPC filed by the petitioner/defendant for correction of final decree dated 12.07.2013 has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has

been compromised between the parties during the pendency of the revision petition and in view of the compromise dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-10) the instant revision petition may be disposed of.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has affirmed the factum of compromise and rather submits that the revision petition may be disposed of in terms of said compromise dated 30.06.2023.

4. Consequently, the present revision petition is disposed of in view of the compromise dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-10) arrived at between the petitioner and contesting respondent No.1 and the Trial Court is directed to modify the decree in terms thereof. Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the compromise.

5. Misc. Application(s) pending, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
