The present appeal has been preferred by the appellant against the order dated 18.10.2023 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby his application for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 14.06.2023 under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC and Section 3 of the SC and ST Act was dismissed.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.11.2023, the appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 01.12.2023 by way of an affidavit of Gurmukh Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarters, Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.11.2023 is made absolute. However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
