Short reply dated 15.02.2023 by way of an affidavit of Balbir Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, has been filed by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Relevant paragraph No. 4 of the said reply says as under:

4. That it is submitted that the police of P.S. Dasuya visited the house of petitioners and they stated in their statements that they have been living together for about two years with their free consent and they have no danger to their life and liberty from anybody. The respondents Des Raj, Balbir Singh, Kewal Singh and Sukhdev Singh stated in their statements that they have no objection if the petitioners live together and they will not interfere in the life of the petitioners. However, if the petitioners will

approach the answering respondents for police protection, the answering respondents will provide police protection to the petitioners.

In view of the stand taken in the said reply, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
