DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in G.D.No.19 dated 08.11.2022 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC in FIR No.89 dated 08.11.2022 registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

On 08.12.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in GD No.19 dated 08.11.2022, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC in FIR No.89 dated 08.11.2022 under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the sister of the petitioner Anuradha is married to one Parminder Singh @ Gagan, who was residing abroad and he used to give her beatings and in that context, an FIR No.0089 dated 08.11.2022 was registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, against the accused persons. It is also submitted that with regard to the same incident, a GD No.19 was also got registered by Parminder Singh @ Gagan, who is husband of Anuradha that the petitioner has caused injuries to him when he visited the in-laws house.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navneet Singh, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of paperbook to counsel opposite during course of the day.

List again on 23.01.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of 15 days from today and he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. *He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
2. *He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
3. *He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court. ”*

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that the State no longer requires the petitioner for investigation purposes.

In the light of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner as have been recorded in the afore quoted order as also the statement made on behalf of the State, the order of this Court dated 08.12.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
