1. This revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is pending from the year 2019.

2. On 17.01.2029, the notice of motion was issued for 23.04.2019. On the next date of hearing, it was noticed that respondent no.1 has died, whereas respondent no.2 is not residing at the given address. The court permitted the petitioner to take steps to bring on record the legal representatives of the respondent no.1 and to provide the correct address of the respondent no.2.

3. On 27.04.2023, once again the learned counsel representing the petitioner sought last opportunity to comply with the order dated 23.04.2019.

4. As per the office report, the learned counsel representing the petitioner has not taken any step to comply with the order dated 23.04.2019.

5. Called twice.

6. The learned counsel representing the petitioner did not come forward to assist the Court. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the revision petition.
7. Hence, dismissed for non-prosecution.
8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
