The instant writ petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950, for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.4 to decide the objection/reply dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against notice dated 12.10.2023 issued by respondent No.4 within a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the aforestated objection/reply filed by the petitioner against the notice issued by

respondent No.4 to remove the encroachment within 07 days, is pending before respondent No.4-Sub Divisional Engineer, Provincial Sub Division No.5, PWD B&R, Branch, Jhajjar. However, the same is not being decided, hence the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in a case a direction is issued to the respondent No.4 to decide objection/reply dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4 to consider the objection/reply dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
