Vide the order dated 09.12.2022, with the consent of the parties, the interim custody of the alleged detainee namely, Amant Kaur, aged about 6 months was handed over to the petitioner, who is the mother of the alleged detainee. Since it was a matrimonial dispute and both the parties had agreed to resolve the dispute amicably, the case was ordered to be placed before the learned SDJM, Samrala on 15.12.2022 for holding the mediation proceedings and to submit a report before this Court, before the next date of hearing. On 01.03.2023, the learned SDJM, Samrala submitted a report and submitted that the mediation sessions were held for four times between the parties, despite putting strenuous efforts, the mediation was unsuccessful and the matter could

not be compromised between the parties. Today the petitioner as well as respondent No.5 is present in person and identified by SI Barjinder Singh. Respondent No.5 submits that he has no objection in case the interim order is made absolute and the custody of the alleged detenue namely, Amant Kaur, aged about 6 months is handed over to the petitioner, who is present in the Court.

In view of the statement made by respondent No.5, the custody of Amant Kaur, aged about 6 months is handed over to the petitioner in the Court itself and no further orders are required to be passed by this Court and the petition is accordingly disposed of.
