1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines the prayer in this petition for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. It is submitted that petitioner is in relationship with one Vaneet Kour and apprehending threat at the hands of her parents, the petitioner along with Vaneet Kour had approached this Court by way of CRWP-10368-2022. The father of aforesaid Vaneet Kour had also filed habeas corpus petition being CRWP-10383-2022. Both the aforesaid petitions were taken up together and disposed of vide order dated 09.11.2022. It is submitted that it had come on record that the detenue was not under illegal detention and was living with the petitioner herein of her own sweet will. Accordingly, the habeas corpus petition was dismissed and the one preferred by the petitioner and said Vaneet Kour was disposed of vide a common order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that thereafter the petitioner has been threatened at the hands of private respondents through police officials. Representation in that regard has been made to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad dated 08.10.2023 but to no avail.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner would be satisfied at this stage if the representation dated 08.10.2023 is disposed of in a time bound manner.

5. Notice of motion to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

6. Mr. Gurbir S. Dhillon, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf the respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives service. He states that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of as per law by Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.2, within the stipulated time.

7. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

8. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or commenting thereon and in view of the submissions noticed above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.2, to dispose of the aforesaid representation dated 08.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
