1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing demand notice dated 10.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) issued under Section 13(2) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002 and notice dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-4) issued under Section 13(4) of SARFAESI Act by respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for respondents submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioners' account has been settled and closed.

3. Perusal of the file reveals that none had appeared on behalf of petitioners on the last two occasions when this writ petition was taken up for hearing. Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

4. Be that as it may, we find no justification for continuance of the present proceedings in view of categoric statement of learned counsel for the respondents-Bank. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.
5. Liberty is afforded to the petitioners to file appropriate application within four weeks in case any incorrect fact has been placed before us.
