1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 556 dated 09.04.2023 registered under Sections 323, 506, 34, 379 of IPC (Section 379/34 IPC has been deleted and Sections 147, 148 & 149 IPC has been added at the time of presenting challan), at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. Vide order dated 06.11.2023, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise.

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal and got their statements recorded.

Report dated 07.12.2023 has been received whereby after recording the

statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

5. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioner.

6. Resultantly, FIR No. 556 dated 09.04.2023 registered under Sections 323, 506, 34, 379 of IPC (Sections 379/34 IPC has been deleted and Sections 147, 148 & 149 IPC has been added at the time of presenting challan), at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
