This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant affiliation to the petitioner college regarding new course M. Tech. Civil (Structural Engineering) with 24 intake for the session 2022-23 as per AICTE approval without causing any further delay. Prayer has also been made in the present Civil Writ Petition for directing the respondents to facilitate the petitioner college to run the new course M. Tech. Civil (Structural Engineering) with 24 intake for the session 2022-23 as per AICTE approval by providing access to the online portals of the University for the purpose of submission of registration form, examination forms and

other necessary documentation requisite for running the new course M.Tech. Civil (Structural Engineering) with 24 intake for the session 2022-23 as per AICTE approval.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as far as the main prayer made by the present petitioners for directing the respondents to grant affiliation to the petitioner college is concerned, same has been satisfied inasmuch as vide letter dated 21.12.2022, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak has provided provisional affiliation to the petitioner college. It is further submitted that after grant of the said affiliation, certain subsequent events have taken place and although, the petitioners are ready to deposit the registration fees as well as examination fees digitally as well as physically but the same was not accepted by the University, as a result of which, the students would not be able to appear in the examinations which are to begin from 25.01.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to file a fresh petition with respect to any such cause which still persists qua the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
