This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.3 to decide the application/petition bearing No.2164-M of 2019 (Annexure P-1) seeking sanctioning of turn of water under Section 68 of the Canal Act of outlet No.14230-L Bhagsar minor village Bannawali.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Om Parkash Sharda, Zileadar, Abohar Division, Fazilka, has submitted that the application (Annexure P-1) would be decided within a period of six weeks from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, he seeks to withdraw the

present writ petition, but prays that the respondents-State be bound by the said statement.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
