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KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. The counsel for the petitioner made prayer that offence under Sections 295/120-B IPC which were later on added by the police be also added in the present petition.
2. Request being genuine is accepted.
3. Registry is directed to do the needful in the head note of the petition with **red ink**, as per rules.

4. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.349 dated 29.9.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 295, 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.
5. This Court vide order dated 9.12.2022 granted interim bail to the petitioner with direction to join investigation.
6. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.
7. State counsel on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.
8. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 9.12.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
