Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to act on the applications dated 15.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) and 28.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) and enter mutation in the revenue record in view of Section 34 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 on the basis of registered sale deeds dated 10.11.2004 and the decision in Civil Suit No.9 of 2005 dated 27.02.2018 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner filed representation dated 28.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) before the Deputy Commissioner, Pathankot but the same has not been taken into consideration by him till date.

Learned State counsel has stated that in case the petitioner files representation before respondent No.3-Tehsildar/Sub Registrar, Tehsil and District Pathankot, Punjab then he will decide the same as per law.

Heard. After hearing the counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation for redressal of his grievance before respondent No.3-Tehsildar/Sub Registrar, Tehsil and District Pathankot, Punjab within ten days from today. If he files any such representation, then respondent No.3 would deal with and decide the same as per law within four weeks from the date of its filing.
