After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the present impugned order has been passed by the Superintending Engineer on the wrong facts, the petitioner intends to approach the higher authorities for raising a grievance that he was fully entitled for the grant of compassionate appointment in the facts and circumstances of the present case and the respondents be directed that in case any such representation is filed, the same be decided in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner approaches any authority raising grievance against the impugned order dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-10), appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision of the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
