The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.46 dated 31.05.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 20.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Bharpur Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
