The limited grievance that is being expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, is that despite repeated representations (P-6, P-8 to P-10) submitted by the petitioner qua its concerns/grievances, the respondent-authorities have failed to address those and as a result, the interest of the petitioner continues to suffer.

Upon being served with an advance copy of the petition, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, on behalf of the respondent-State, and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3, are present in Court.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 submits that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, to enable the authorities to examine the representations (P-6, P-8 to P-10) submitted by the petitioner, which are pending consideration before the competent authority. And pass appropriate

orders, in accordance with law. Further, he submits that before any such order is passed, the petitioner shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties. And, as undertaken by learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3, the respondent authorities shall pass the necessary order within a period of six weeks from today. Needless to assert that a speaking order shall be passed, assigning reasons in support thereof.

It is made clear that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the case of either party, for, as indicated above, the respondent authority shall examine the grievances of the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law.
