1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the terms and conditions of the bond which the petitioners were made to sign is different than one which has been signed by the other doctors which are doing the post graduation degree/diploma courses after completion of 2 years of regular service. Learned counsel further submits that the terms and conditions of the bond should be akin as all the doctors are from the same department and mere 2 years lesser service/more service should not be a ground for different terms and conditions in the bond.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised a grievance through the legal notice dated 01.07.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-3, and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case time bound direction is given to the respondent by this Court by passing an appropriate speaking order.

AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case, legal notice (Annexure P-3) dated 01.07.2023 has been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the copy of this order.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
