DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This first petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.92 dated 21.10.2022 registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Kotli Surat Mallian, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and she is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated

09.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
