JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0861 dated 21.09.2022 registered under Sections 420, 466 and 468 IPC at Police Station State Hisar City Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.12.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner makes any attempt whatsoever to prevent the complainant and/or representatives entering into the property, the complainant is at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail.

Petition stands disposed of.
