In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that as per his calculation, the petitioner should have secured more marks than the last selected candidate keeping in view the answer given by the petitioner in the preliminary examination but the petitioner has not been selected in the result dated 06.10.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised before the respondents by way of representation dated 27.10.2023, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-11 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Dr. Neha Awasthi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-Commission.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-11) has been received in the office of Commission and the same is still pending, appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
