The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.47 dated 01.08.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

By virtue of the order dated 20.12.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He has submitted that the petitioner has also deposited the amount of Rs.1,50,000/- with the trial Court and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
