On 12.12.2022 the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing the order dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) passed in CIS No.CHA/76/2019 with regard to FIR No.108 dated 21.04.2019 under Section 3 and 13-A of The Punjab Gambling Act, 1867 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali with prayer for issuance of directions to furnish fresh bail bonds before the Trial Court.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner inadvertently did not appear on 21.12.2021 before the trial Court. He is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 14.02.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the Trial court within a period of one week from

today subject to his depositing Rs.20,000/- as cost with Guru Ravidas Sabha, PGI, Sector 12, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in furtherance of the said order the petitioner has surrendered and since been released on interim bail vide order dated 17.12.2022.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.

However, it is expected that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself from the proceedings except for sufficient cause.
