VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.4 not to take any further action on department proceedings before respondent no.4 till the pendency of the criminal proceedings/trial arising out of FIR no.109 dated 08.02.2022 registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, Haryana, under Sections 34,120-B, 201, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently the petitioner has annexed the charge sheet of Yogesh Lamba instead of annexing that of present petitioner and thus, seeks to withdraw

the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed, then the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
