The instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair investigation in the case FIR No.61 dated 20.10.2023 under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at P.S. Patara, District Jalandhar Rural (Annexure P-6).

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners had dispute with private respondents on account of adoption of child and to pressurize the petitioners, the respondent No.8 has got registered FIR (Annexure P-6) against the petitioners in order to exert pressure on flimsy grounds. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that they have moved representation to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, (Annexure P-7) dated 26.10.2023, for conducting fair and impartial investigation in the matter, but till date, no action thereon has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if

appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-7) dated 26.10.2023 in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition by learned counsel for the petitioners, without commenting on the purpose of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 26.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioners in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioners as well.

6. Disposed of.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
