The prayer in the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to recover and produce the detenue-Muskan who has been illegally abducted by the private respondents.

In pursuance to the order dated 03.11.2023, the alleged detenue-Muskan is present in the Court. She states that she is happily residing with respondent No.8-Bismillah wife of Hamid who is her maternal-grand-mother and does not wish to reside with the petitioner who is her husband.

In view of the categoric statement of the alleged detenue-Muskan, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.
