1. The petitioner (minor) through his father and natural guardian, by virtue of instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking directions to the respondents to issue him passport.
2. The petitioner is a 12 years old minor child. The petitioner was born from the wedlock of Balwinder Singh and Gurpeet Kaur. The marriage of the parents of the petitioner stands dissolved vide order dated 15.11.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by District Judge, Ludhiana. The petitioner is staying with his father and he has applied for the passport.
3. Ms. Amrita Singh, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, submits that petitioner along with his father may be directed to appear before competent authority who after

considering case of the petitioner shall pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks thereafter.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid agreement.

5. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before respondent No.2 on 30.11.2023 along with his father at 10:00 AM.
