Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that suit was filed on 13.06.2023 and application for grant of temporary injunction was also moved. The Court below issued notice but the learned Civil Judge has not been deciding an application filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC. He has referred orders dated 07.08.2023, 20.09.2023 and 09.11.2023 where it has been shown that service is complete but there is no where mentioned that an application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC is pending and the same is to be considered.

learned Civil Judge, Junior Division be disposed of in a time bound manner.

It is the duty of the Court to decide application for temporary injunction on priority basis. If such applications are not decided, the rule of law cannot prevail and antisocial persons take the law into their own hands.

The learned Civil Judge is directed to dispose of the application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC by 15.12.2023 positively.
