Having married against the wishes of their family members, petitioners are now feeling threatened to their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6 and have prayed for granting them protection by way of this petition.

2. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 was earlier unmarried. Though petitioner No.2 – Ankit Kumar was earlier married but his marriage with the earlier wife was declared void vide order dated 13.05.2022 passed by Family Court, Saharanpur. Copy of that order has been placed on record.

3. The petition is accompanied by copy of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P.1 and P.2) showing the petitioners to be major, copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P.4) revealing that they have performed marriage on 30.10.2023. Annexure P.3 is the photographs of marriage, besides copy of representation (Annexure P.5) dated 30.10.2023 which was made to respondent No.2.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

6. The petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to 3 to provide necessary protection to the petitioners after considering threat perceptions to their life and liberty.

7. This order is passed without any comment on the validity of the marriage.
