1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR bearing No.70 dated 12.06.2022, Annexure P-1, registered for offences under Sections 324 and 34, IPC, Section 307, IPC, was added, later on, at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise Deeds dated 21.06.2022 and 19.10.2023, Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively, arrived at between the parties.

2. Petitioners No.1 and 2 had approached the Court earlier by filing CRM-M-41437-2022, along with co-accused, Rohit @ Gappy, for quashing of FIR, Annexure P-1, on the basis of Compromise Deed dated 30.07.2022, which was withdrawn on 15.12.2022. They have, however, failed to disclose the same, rather in para 9 of the present petition, a declaration has been given to the effect "That no such or similar petition has earlier been filed in this Hon'ble
