This is an application for placing on record copy of affidavit of the complainant – Ramandeep Singh dated 11.10.2023 as Annexure P.4 regarding the compromise effected amongst the parties.

Application is allowed. Annexure P.4 is taken on record.

CRM-M-55725 of 2023

By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.97 dated 27.09.2023 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 336, 148, 149, 427 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Arniwala.

Contention of learned counsel is that petitioner along with co-accused is alleged to have attacked the complainant Ramandeep Singh and caused injuries to him. It is further contended that only non-bailable offences are under Sections 452 IPC and 25 and 27 of Arms Act and the matter has since been compromised vide Annexure P.4. Learned counsel also contended that coaccused VijaySingh was

even allowed the benefit of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 06.11.2023 in CRM-M-55414 of 2023. Besides another co-accused Yogesh has also allowed regular bail by the Sessions Court vide order dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P.2).

Status report has been filed. It is not disputed by learned State Counsel that Ramandeep Singh is the only injured in this case.

As per affidavit of Ramandeep Singh placed on record vide Annexure P.4, the matter has been compromised between the parties. Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 28.09.2023. Further trial may take long time to conclude.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
