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**VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 27.09.2023 (Annexure P-14) whereby representation of the petitioner has been rejected.

2. On 09.11.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the impugned order is cryptic and non-speaking and has not taken into consideration the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled as **“Jigyada Yadav (minor) (through Guardian/father Hari Singh) Vs. CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) and others”**, and other connected matters, reported as **2021(7) SCC 535**.*

*Notice of motion for 06.12.2023.*

*To be taken up at 12.00 noon.”*

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.1-Board has fairly submitted that a fresh order would be passed in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in a detailed judgment passed in case titled as **Jigya Yadav (minor) (through Guardian/father Hari Singh) Vs. CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) and others** and other connected matters reported as **2021(7) SCC 535** and after considering the entire issue afresh.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is partly allowed and order dated 27.09.2023 (Annexure P-14) is set aside with direction to respondent No.1-Board to pass fresh order after taking into consideration the documents annexed along with the present writ petition and the law laid down in the case of **Jigya Yadav (minor)**. The same be done within a period of three weeks from today.
