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SANJIV BERRY, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 381 dated 20.08.2022 under Section 279 and 337 IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 02.12.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Naraingarh vide report dated 30.01.2023, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

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[3]. Respondents No. 2 and 3 are represented by their counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

[4]. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Naraingarh, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”*, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and *“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”*, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainants have himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused person.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 381 dated 20.08.2022 under Section 279 and 337 IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.12.2022 (Annexure P-2), are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
