The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking direction to official respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioner that wife of the petitioner is not permitting him to enjoy his accommodation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* submits that petitioner is working as Constable with Chandigarh Police and the dispute is between the petitioner and his wife. The petitioner is staying separately from his wife still his wife is not permitting him to enter his house and creating problems. The petitioner has made representation dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) to jurisdictional police authority and they may be directed to look into the matter.

assures the Court that jurisdictional police authority would look into the matter and redress the grievance of the petitioner.
