1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he was already in service when the new pension scheme was made effective from 01.01.2006, hence, keeping in view the judgment of this Hon'ble Court passed in ***CWP No. 2371 of 2010*** decided on 31.08.2010 titled ***Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others***, the petitioner is entitled to be considered under the old pension scheme.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition has already been raised through the legal notice dated 28.09.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-22 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, time bound direction is given to the respondent by this Court by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case, legal notice (Annexure P-22) dated 28.09.2023 has been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him within a further period of 2 weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
