Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to petitioner in FIR No.225 dated 14.07.2019, under Section 302, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Asauda, Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

(2) Concededly, an application of the petitioner for seeking regular bail was rejected by learned trial Court way back on 06.11.2020. Thus, a period of more than 3 years has gone by. Therefore, this Court deems it appropriate to relegate the petitioner to take recourse to remedy for seeking bail pending trial before learned trial Court.

(3) Learned trial Court is requested that in case an application is moved within one week, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law within next two weeks, if there is no legal impediment.

(4) Disposed off accordingly.
