Present application has been filed for placing on record counter affidavit of petitioner to the affidavit filed by respondent No.3 and photographs as Annexure P-6.

For the reasons recorded in the application, same is allowed and counter affidavit of petitioner to the affidavit filed by respondent No.3 along with photographs is ordered to be taken on record as Annexure P-6.

CM-12538-CWP-2023

Present application has been filed for preponing the date of hearing fixed in the main petition.

For the reasons recorded in the application, prayer for preponing the date of hearing in the main case is allowed.

Let the main case is taken on Board today itself for consideration.

CWP-28954-2022

Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to immediately shift the Garbage Dump from the residential area of City Patran which causes the serious threat of spread of disease and also causing the accident due to stray cattle and bulls. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondent to take a final decision on the representations dated 21.08.2019 and 19.10.2022 of the petitioners as (Annexures P-2 and P-4).

It has been contended by learned counsel for respondent No.3 that the site in dispute where the garbage was being segregated is no more being used for the said purpose as the respondent has shifted the place for the same purpose and thus, no further grievance remains with the petitioner, however, he submits that respondent No.3 is legally bound to maintain the hygienic conditions in accordance with law.

He submits that respondents No.3 in para No.5 of the status report dated 04.10.2023 has submitted that the land in dispute is owned by Local Administration. However, learned counsel for the petitioners disputes the same and submits that it belongs to the petitioners and the other writ petitioners. The same is being disputed by learned counsel for respondent No.3.

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However, this Court refrains from commenting anything on the ownership of the property and the parties are at liberty to agitate the same before the appropriate forum in accordance with law.
